



The suite was created by Parisian architect and designer Jean-Michel Wilmotte with the assistance of Coppola himself, who donated items from his personal archive to bring the magic of Hollywood to life in this oneof-a-kind abode.

PLANTING AN OASIS IN THE HEART OF OXFORD STREET

AMBITIOUS PLANS TO REDEVELOP LONDON'S CAVENDISH SQUARE into a four-storey subterranean medical, wellness and retail destination have been submitted to Westminster City Council, with a view to turning the Georgian square into the UK capital's hottest lifestyle hub. Accessed via a glass-roofed tunnel that will allow natural light to flood into the underground levels, the development will have a strong medical and wellness focus, extending the reach of the nearby Harley Street Medical Area to provide space for new wellbeing-focused businesses, in light of the growing demand for health and wellbeing services in the city.

The £100 million (\$128 million) project envisaged by the UK's Reef Group will link Harley Street to the flagship retail stores and luxury boutiques of Oxford Street thanks to the redevelopment of 280,000 sq ft of underground space (currently occupied by a car park) and the sensitive restoration of Cavendish Square itself. When complete, the square will be home to three new entrances facing Oxford Street, Regent Street and Harley Street, newly landscaped gardens and an outdoor event space.

If plans are approved, work will begin next year in the hope that the first businesses can move in by 2022, creating a new oasis in the heart of busy Oxford Street.

AMAN KYOTO Kyoto, Japan

Aman's quest for otherworldly locations has led it to Kyoto for its newest retreat, nestled among 32 hectares of peaceful forest. Set in a valley blanketed in trees whose leaves change colour with the season, Aman Kyoto is a destination in its own right, just a 20 minutes scenic walk from the UNESCO World Heritage Kinkaku-ji Temple. Mosscovered pathways wind through sculpted gardens and the hotel's six guest pavilions, where 26 guestrooms, designed by Kerry Hill, take Aman's signature minimalist style to a whole new level. Walking through the forest to the Aman Spa is the first step on a journey to inner wellbeing, which is completed with a dip in spring-fed onsen baths, and healing treatments infused with local ingredients. ANDAZ DUBAI THE PALM Dubai, UAE

Every now and again a new hotel comes along that breaks the mould and puts its own unique stamp on a destination. That's certainly the case with Andaz Dubai The Palm, the first outpost of Hyatt's funky lifestyle brand to open its doors in the Emirate. Situated on the trunk of Palm Jumeirah on a 300-metre stretch of beach, the hotel feels contemporary and fresh, but there's a distinct sense of Emirati culture running through too. The eastern coast of Baja California stretches more than 1,200 kilometres along the Sea of Cortez, the warm gulf separating the peninsula from the mainland that's home to whale sharks and abundant marine life. Nestled along its own 3.2 kilometre stretch of beach, Four Seasons Resort Los Cabos at Costa Palmas is the latest addition to this gleaming coastline, with 141 guestrooms and suites bearing traditional Mexican motifs incorporated into gorgeous contemporary interiors. Junior jetsetters will be well looked after thanks to the Kids for All Seasons programme, while parents sneak off to the Oasis Spa and Wellness Centre or one of five dining options, including an outpost of acclaimed Greek seafood restaurant Estiatorio Milos. 

Onboard entertainment includes Russian language lessons, talks on the Northern Lights by the accompanying astronomer, elegant afternoon teas, vodka tasting sessions and spare hours to idly enjoy the epic passing landscape. For an additional cost there's the opportunity to book snowmobile tours and husky-sledging too during stop offs.

2. WINTER WATERWORLD

Take wonder to a new stratosphere with an Arctic journey that will have you heli-skiing, whale watching, snowmobiling, ice hiking and husky-sledging by day and sleeping on a superyacht by night. This adventure cruise in Greenland is as lavish as a winter break could be, with options to book a suite aboard the Legend or charter the whole mega-yacht with 13 cabins for family and friends. 


