

AMAN SETS SAIL WITH PROJECT SAMA



SINCE ITS CREATION IN 1988, AMAN HAS OFFERED TRANSFORMATIVE TRAVEL

experiences in an ever-growing collection of handsome resorts, building a loyal following of well-heeled travellers over the last three decades. With 32 resorts and one urban address now in operation, and eight more under construction - including the much-anticipated Aman New York, which will open in May - the company has been exploring new niche markets for the last few years, introducing Aman Residences to most new projects and a range of ready-to-wear retail items: The Essentials by Aman.

The next step is perhaps the most exciting yet for the company. Project Sama is the working title for the first Aman superyacht, a 183metre vessel that promises exceptional travel experiences at sea. Developed via a joint venture with Cruise Saudi, the government-backed body responsible for developing Saudi Arabia's nascent cruise industry, Project Sama will be home to 50 spacious suites averaging 100 square metres, each with a private balcony, as well as an Aman Spa and Japanese garden, two helipads, a beach club and selection of dining options.

Designed by Dutch superyacht studio Sinot

Yacht Architecture & Design, which specialises in seamlessly integrating indoor and outdoor spaces, interiors will blend Aman's Eastern heritage and design philosophy with the architectural demands of a modern luxury motor vacht. Though no details about itineraries have been confirmed, Aman COO Roland Fasel said Project Sama was likely to split its time between the Mediterranean and the Red Sea when it launches in 2025. The project marks the next step in Aman's relationship with the Kingdom, where it is currently developing properties in Riyadh, AlUla and the Red Sea. www.aman.com

KEMPINSKI UNVEILS FLOATING DUBAI RESORT

THE WORD 'IMPOSSIBLE' ISN'T OFTEN USED IN DUBAI, a mindset that has led to the Emirate growing from Arabian backwater to global powerhouse and luxury travel hub in a handful of decades. Home to the tallest building in the world, the world's largest shopping mall and a series of other superlatives, Dubai is ceaseless in its ambition.

Kempinski Floating Palace Dubai is the latest visionary project to emerge from the city: a modular floating hotel anchored in the Arabian Gulf between Jumeirah Beach and The World Islands, surrounded by 12 luxury motor villas, which can be cast off and sailed away along the UAE coast.

The main hotel building will be bisected by a cavernous tunnel with moorings for up to 16 yachts, giving guests the choice of arriving via the hotel speedboat or on their own vessel. A glass pyramid will connect the two halves of the main building, which will be home to 156 rooms and suites, as well as a collection of restaurants and bars, a spa, swimming pools, boutiques and banqueting areas.

The 12 villas, which range from two to four bedrooms, will be available for private ownership and added to the hotel accommodation when not in use by owners. Each will boast two floors of living space surrounded by panoramic windows, with rooftop terraces, infinity pools and all the features of a modern smart home. There's also room for crew and staff to live aboard when sailing to another port.

The bold project was envisioned by UAE-based Seagate Shipyard, which has posted images of its conceptual 'Glass Boat Villa' - the model for the 12 floating villas - on its LinkedIn page. The modular nature of the design means the entire resort will be built onshore and shipped to its final destination when construction is complete in around 18 months, marking another milestone for Dubai and Kempinski, which celebrates its 125th anniversary this year. www.kempinski.com



DORCHESTER COLLECTION HAS NAMED ITS LONG-AWAITED DUBAI HOTEL THE LANA, BLENDING AN ARABIC EXPRESSION MEANING "FOR US" AND A HAWAIIAN TERM MEANING "FLOATING GENTLY IN CALM WATER". WHEN SAUDI ARABIA WAS ESTABLISHED, THE FOREFATHERS OF THE HOUSE OF SAUD made their home in Diriyah, 15 minutes outside modern-day Riyadh. The mudbrick houses, palaces and mighty citadel at At-Turaif began to spring up in 1766, built in the Najdi architectural style characteristic of the Arabian Peninsula at the time. Today, At-Turaif is recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and forms the heart of one of the most ambitious tourism development projects in the world: Diriyah Gate.

When complete, the 11 square kilometre project will be home to a

collection of museums, residential neighbourhoods, shopping areas and more than 100 restaurants and cafes, as well as an arts district, souks and bazaars and a collection of 38 hotels and resorts. The Diriyah Gate Development Authority (DGDA), which is overseeing the project, has revealed the names of the first 14 international hotels brands selected to manage properties within the development: a star-studded line-up of big names that will bring their own unique characters to the city.

The first 12 hotels are part of the main Diriyah Gate area, which will become a heritage, tourism

and lifestyle destination on the edge of the historic city. Familiar international brands including Raffles, Park Hyatt, The Ritz-Carlton, Rosewood, Capella and The Luxury Collection will be joined by regional luxury names including Address Hotels & Resorts and Beirut-based Campbell Gray Hotels & Resorts. Smaller brands including Baccarat, LXR and the recently revitalised Orient Express will also open properties, while French haute gastronomy brand Fauchon will open its first ever hotel in the city.

To the west of Diriyah, Wadi Safar is another master-planned part of the development set in 60 square kilometres of natural landscape that was once a gathering place for travellers from all over the world and a vital hub on the Spice Route. Here, another collection of luxury resorts will find their home, including properties from Oberoi and Six Senses.

Helmed by hospitality veteran Jerry Inzerillo, group CEO of DGDA, the US \$50 billion giga-project will welcome the first new hotels starting with The Luxury Collection later this year. Eventually, Diriyah Gate will be home to a population of 100,000 residents, breathing new life into the ancestral home of the Al Saud royal family. www.diriyah.sa


ANANTARA WORLD ISLANDS DUBAI RESORT Dubai, UAF


The 300 man-made islands that emerge from the waters of the Arabian Gulf just off the coast of Jumeirah Beach are collectively known as The World, one of the most ambitious projects undertaken by Dubai developer Nakheel. Last month, Anantara World Islands Dubai Resort became the first hotel in the archipelago: a castaway island escape with 70 rooms, suites and villas in the South America portion of The World. Guestrooms are bright and modern, while the larger suites and villas make use of sea grass, rattan and other natural materials to emphasise the castaway experience. Most of the beach and garden villas have private pools and large outdoor terraces; our favourite is the Beach Pool Villa, whose cavernous open-plan interior is made entirely of bamboo and woven natural fibres. Guests bound for the private island will check in at sister property Anantara Dubai The Palm Resort before making the 15-minute boat ride across to The World. Day visitors and can moor their private boats to the resort jetty and stop in for sundowners, skyline views and South American specialities at beachfront bar and lounge Luna, while overnight guests can feast on Arabic-Indian and Mediterranean dishes at Qamar and Helios respectively. www.anantara.com

FAIRMONT WINDSOR PARK Windsor IJK

Surrounded by bucolic English countryside a stone's throw from Windsor Castle, Fairmont Windsor Park provides a rural counterpoint to the brand's legendary London address, The Savoy. With 40 acres of landscaped gardens that blend into the sprawling expanse of neighbouring Windsor Great Park, the weekend home of Queen Elizabeth II, guests will find themselves immersed in countryside pursuits from the moment they arrive. Health and wellness takes centre stage at Fairmont Spa & Wellness, home to a multiperson cryotherapy chamber, a 20-metre lap pool with floating loungers, a Japanese foot spa, a meditation and dry flotation room. Among the 200 guestrooms, the Signature Royal Suite reigns supreme, with private entrance and direct access to the ultra-discreet Salutaris Suite, a VIP area within the spa with its own private hot tub, steam room and relaxation area. Dining options include 1215 at Fairmont Windsor Park, where fresh produce from The Royal Farms is transformed by head chef Luke Fouracre into modern British dishes; European and Middle Eastern fusion at MOREISH; gin-based creations at Schroders' Botanicals Bar; and a tea room, café and event spaces. www.accor.com

Facing a sheltered bay with direct access to the warm waters of the Arabian Gulf, the resort is home to 388 rooms and suites that afford panoramic views across Marjan Island and the craggy peaks of the Yanis and Jais Mountains beyond. Six restaurants and bars provide a wealth of options: there's all-day international dining at RBG Restaurant and beach-facing beverages at RBG Bar; Mediterranean fare at La Med; and light bites at The Shelf Pool Bar. Guests can find their caffeine fix in the lobby café Bake House and The Seafood Shack is home to a raw bar, live-fire barbeque and fresh seafood. In addition to the resort's own facilities, which include two swimming pools, a dedicated kids pool, and a fitness centre with a fully-equipped gym and spa, some of Ras Al Khaimah's soul-stirring attractions are on the doorstep, including the rolling dunes of the Al Wadi Nature Reserve and the spectacular Hajar Mountains, home to the UAE's highest peak and its adrenalin-pumping zipline, Jebel Jais Flight. www.radisson.com
