



Green fingers meet blue waters at Angsana Ihuru this month with its "Live For Adventure" package. The resort is stepping up to the coral plate to help protect the Indian Ocean's delicate ecosystem. 



# GOURMETISLAND

A far-flung island in the Maldives has become a bona fide foodie destination writes Elizabeth Wentling, who visits Conrad Maldives Rangali Island to discover a host of delicious – and otherworldly – dining experiences



he embodiment of a tropical screen saver, there is no shortage of beauty throughout the 26 atolls of the Maldives. And beyond the coral reefs and otherworldly sightings of whale sharks, travellers can steal away to a paradise that offers total seclusion without compromising on life's greatest pleasures. This is where Conrad Maldives Rangali Island, a five-star playground offering top-shelf pastimes for those serious about luxury, comes in – albeit, as I happily discovered not long after arriving, with a leaning towards the delectable.

Yes, all the trappings of a fabulous island residency are in place: spas, outdoor yoga sessions, boat cruises, snorkelling with rainbow fish, and infinity pools galore. But Conrad Maldives knows its food-focused clientele, and it's clear this exotic island hotel has earned its reputation as a genuine

foodie destination, with more than a dozen ways to dine and drink on the menu. Add to that memorable gourmand experiences, such as Lobsters and Champagne on the Beach, and getting bored ceases to be an option.

For most people arriving at Rangali, the first culinary impression is made at Rangali Bar, where thatched-palm roofs soar above guests stretched out on chaise longues with a glass of rosé in hand, gazing at the lagoon and seaplanes arriving and departing throughout the afternoon. The bar's relaxed atmosphere gives way to tables dotting the sand beneath trees illuminated by fairy lights, all a stone's throw from vividly blue water.

My go-to item from the international menu is the Catch of the Day. The dish presents grilled grouper fillet enhanced with a squeeze of fresh lemon, accompanied by fresh vegetables, chips, salad and rice, along with a wine recommendation by the all-knowing staff ("A crisp sauvignon blanc, perhaps?"). Lazy lunches are de rigueur on Rangali, paired with ever-present sea breezes and idyllic swaying palms.

Next door is the Atoll Market, an open-air kitchen where the hotel's guests can graze freely in the morning on a truly international breakfast; the Maldives is a popular destination for the Chinese and there's no shortage of noodles, dumplings and other traditional Schezuan fare. Beyond the Asian cuisine, a juice bar serves freshly squeezed concoctions of beet, cucumber, ginger and apple alongside





the Italian bistro, where the Market offers fresh cold cuts, international cheeses, smoked salmon and made-to-order crêpes and waffles.

Between lounging at the pool, or adventuring into the sea to catch a wave or glimpse of marine wildlife, there's one restaurant that every guest considers a must-see and must-dine: Ithaa Undersea Restaurant, the world's first glass underwater restaurant. This restaurant not only caught the world's attention with its one-of-a-kind environment, it elevated the Maldives to a bucket-list destination for jet setters seeking luxurious experiences deemed out of this world.

Upon entering Ithaa's lobby, tucked inside an overwater villa built in classic Maldivian style, I'm handed a chilled flute of champagne before heading downstairs to the restaurant where my meal will be accompanied by a view of sharks and schools of fish. Dining at Ithaa is not just unforgettable, it's borderline ethereal, and the menu matches the spectacular view with saffron champagne risotto and truffle dumplings served with Russian caviar.

Over the water at Mandhoo Restaurant, one of the island's open-air restaurants, I sample a spa-inspired menu based on its "Five Elements" theory: air (energising), fire (detoxifying), earth (nourishing), water (relaxing) and plant (fortifying). With certain dishes offering ingredients intended nurture good health and harmonise the body, this health-centric space is all about transparency while maintaining the highest quality of taste. Every plate at

Mandhoo includes a breakdown of calories, protein, cholesterol, fat and saturated fat. When it comes to ordering, the staff encourages you to follow your heart's desire, but their in-house nutritionist is there to assist in making any decisions to complement your diet. The crabmeat salad with avocado and mango, dressed with a grapefruit and blueberry granité came highly recommended. I obliged, and am glad that I did because the savoury-sweet shellfish dish, followed by equally tender nori-crusted beef tenderloin and teriyaki shiitake mushrooms, was exceptional.

Desserts – with a health spin, naturally – include unique options like organic cheesecake; a panna cotta of caramelised tofu, fine sea salt and organic kumquat confit;

> and fruit soup with tapioca pearls. Everything is handcrafted under the same roof, and the sauces, garnishes, jellies and jams each result in a world-class standard of freshness.

> Speaking to executive chef Marco Amarone, who credits the surrounding environment as his inspiration, I'm won over by his enthusiasm for the island's latest development towards a hydroponic garden where Thai chillies, mint, basil and a variety of lettuces are grown on-site. Anything the island cannot grow organically or obtain locally is flown in fresh, but Amarone is eager to minimise this in the future.

> This philosophy is clear at Ufaa, by Chinese celebrity chef Jereme Leung, which offers seafood platters from local fishermen, and dishes from Leung's homeland such as hot pots where assorted vegetables, meats and shellfish are dipped into and cooked in boiling-hot saltwater.

> Along with Leung's Asian flair, it's possible to taste the flavours of Europe, Africa, India and local Maldivian delicacies all within Conrad Maldives; each restaurant stands on its own with memorable dining. This is just another supporting detail that makes this destination extraordinary, and Rangali will not only win over your heart – you can actually eat your heart out.

# MARKS THE SPOT

W Retreat & Spa - Maldives and discovers a luxury-island playground where anything goes



T'S JUST AFTER MIDDAY AND THERE'S A BUBBLE around in mesh kaftans and aviators, a slender blonde DJ in gladiator sandals is spinning funky house beats, and a mixologist from the UK has flown in to hold a cocktail masterclass. It may be the Maldives, but the W is not your typical honeymoon island paradise.

Of course, W has never been typical, nor is it a brand machine set up at the pool area. Couples are lounging that plays by the rules. Where other hotels accentuate with neutral tones, W uses neon pink. Other hotels use the term concierge; W has an Insider who promises to deliver "Whatever/Whenever". It's daring, it's devil-may-care and oh my is it chic, especially when it's on a paradise island in the Maldives.



After jetting down at W Retreat & Spa - Maldives on a seaplane, skidding across overwhelmingly turquoise water, I'm greeted by a troupe of staff clad in white and offering cocktails. From the second my foot hits the jetty, it's clear I've landed on W island - and not just because there's a massive letter "W" standing tall on the pier; rather, it's the music. As one of the brand's biggest passion points, music is ubiquitous on the island. Bose speakers are hidden in the sides of the jetties, beats are playing in the golf buggies used to ferry guests around the island, and all retreats are fitted with indoor and outdoor Bose speakers. There's even an app you can download to stream W's signature sounds, so you are never without your fix.

The retreat is situated on Fesdu island, a palm-fringed paradise in the North Ari Atoll with overwater villas stretching across the shallow lagoon and seafront villas with private plunge pools facing the beach. The interiors, which recently underwent a little nip 'n tuck, were unveiled with the aptly named theme Let It Glow, a collaboration between

cutting-edge design influencers to highlight the island's natural, glowing wonders: namely, the fluorescent plankton and twinkling stars.

Set on the beach, the retreat's Wonderful Beach Oasis retreats are styled with splashes of red, from rope hammock chairs handcrafted by communities in Nicaragua to jellyfishand coral-emblazoned cushions, along with chic marineinspired elements like rope lamps designed by Christian Haas. With direct beach access, the turquoise shallows peeking temptingly through the palms, the retreats have daybeds, an upper deck with water views and generous outdoor bathrooms with a tub.

Things get bigger, bolder and more beautiful for those staying overwater. The Fabulous Lagoon Oasis overwater villas feature private plunge pools on the sundeck and glass panels in the floor that at night illuminate the reef below. Design pieces like stingray-shaped rocking chairs by Thomas Pedersen are scattered throughout. The pool and glass panels increase in size in the Extreme Wow Ocean Escape, a two-bedroom junior suite with stairs that lead from the sundeck into the lagoon, while in the Extreme Wow Ocean Haven, every amenity from the bathtubs to the infinity pool is supersized. There's even a piano, a relic left over by one of W's wealthy guests, who requested it be moved from his yacht to his suite by the time he arrived.

A chat with Chunky Matthews, the retreat's W Insider, reveals some of the other astonishing lengths W has gone to please their guests. Aside from the piano, Chunky once arranged for a fish, caught by a group of holidaying Russians,







Sit down at one of five restaurants and lounges to indulge in gourmet dining and refreshing cocktails - but be sure not to miss the overwater Lighthouse Restaurant, ideal for romantic evenings and fine food such as fresh oysters and lobster, enjoyed while rays and fish can be seen swimming below. After a day of discovery and Maldivian hospitality, sumptuously appointed villas wait with teak floors, local design touches, large beds with pillow menus and secluded personal terraces. A sought-after destination for honeymoon and anniversary celebrations, overwater villas with private plunge pools, a dedicated villa host and direct access to the translucent lagoon ensure a getaway that won't be soon forgotten.

# FLIGHT OF FANCY

A low-cost airline may not be the first choice for discerning travellers, however Michelle Wranik-Hicks finds flydubai's business class an affordable indulgence

WORDS LIKE "LUXURY" AND "LOW COST" rarely go together, but since flying with flydubai between Dubai International Airport and the Maldives, I'm no longer so sure they shouldn't. Flying to Malé four times a week, the budgetairline's business-class offering is a savvy way to save money without compromising on luxury, and the new departure gate set aside exclusively for business passengers at Terminal 2 allows for a seamless, speedy and decidedly "unbudget" boarding experience.

WITH ONLY 12 SEATS IN **BUSINESS. THE FRONT** END FEELS INTIMATE AND SPACIOUS

After a swift priority check-in, I head to the airline's Business Lounge, located just after duty free, providing a welcome respite from Terminal 2's frenetic hubbub. The two-level lounge is on the small side with café-style seating and little atmosphere on the lower level, and armchairs and a bar on the upper level, but the food and beverage options are impressive, including pastries, salads and a handful of hot meals, with a variety of teas, coffee and juices.

Business passengers are requested to be at the departure gate 20 minutes prior to take off

for fast-track boarding; I'm seated for less than 10 minutes before a dedicated minibus service arrives, transferring me to the aircraft within minutes. As the first passenger to board, I'm smiling cabin crew hand me hot towels and a round of pumpkin pie. choice of apple or orange juice.

end feels intimate and spacious (particularly when it turns out I'm the only passenger flying business). Crafted from a deep-blue, custom-Italian leather, the seat pitch is 106.6 cm with a 17.7-cm recline and an extendable leg rest that raises at the touch of a button. The tray table emerges from the chair arm, and there's more than enough room to whip out the laptop and work, with plenty of all-important arm space separating you from the adjacent passenger. To power up, there's also a universal plug socket **FARE**: From US\$1,640

fitted into the lower section of the seat. A bottle of water and complimentary flydubai Philtek noise-cancelling headphones are stowed within the armrest compartment.

If you'd rather relax, the in-flight entertainment includes a 30.7-cm highdefinition screen with a decent selection of films and television shows, free for business passengers, while the eReader allows digital access to 45 newspaper titles in seven languages. The user interface is touch screen and easy to navigate, and I experience no glitches during my movie watching.

The route to Malé is a red-eye so I don't peruse the menu, and instead gratefully accept the offer of a second pillow and blanket from cabin crew. Upon arrival, I am given priority to disembark the plane before other passengers.

The morning return leg to Dubai flies via Colombo, Sri Lanka, and though there's a change in cabin crew after the stopover, the service remains consistent and is no less delightful. From Malé, my freshly brewed coffee arrives with cookies and chocolates. From Colombo, a three-course meal is served atop a tablecloth and on white china, the airline offering halal, vegetarian, beef or chicken selection from the mains. My delicious braised beef is served with creamy mash and vegetables, along with greeted warmly and the service is genuine - a salad of leaves and pasta shells, and a baked

There may be no flat bed or Bulgari amenities, With only 12 seats in business, the front but for a low-cost airline, business class is a pleasant surprise (clearly even for economy passengers - just watch their expressions as they mistakenly take their seats in the first rows) and flydubai pulls it off convincingly.
